- Possess appropriate hand-eye coordination and manual dexterity



**PRE-APPRENTICESHIP
BY THE NUMBERS**

On average, of the previous women attending pre-apprenticeship training programs through YWCA Toronto:

- 10% entered into formal apprenticeships
- 60% found work within in the industry in related jobs
- 70% of women increased their earnings
- 10% pursued further education in other career paths

■ Academic Upgrading

Tuesday, March 29 - Friday, April 22 | 9:30am-2:30pm

Calculations, metric conversion, scale conversion, trade specific research data/reports, terminology, grammar, computer literacy and essential skills for employment.

■ Safety Training

Monday, April 25 - Friday, April 29 | 9am-3pm

Safety training for the trade including Infrastructure Health and Safety Association (IHSA) Working at Heights, Fall Arrest, Powered Elevated Work Platforms (PEWPs), Scaffold, Swing Stage, Rigging, and more.

■ Level 1 Certificate

Monday, May 2 - Friday, July 15 | 9am-3pm

Basic apprenticeship instruction in primary trade (Painter-Decorator) and exposure to secondary trade (Architectural Glass and Metal Technician) with hands-on skills application and visits to work sites to meet employers and network with other journey-people working in the trade.

■ Paid Work Placement

Monday, July 18 - Friday, September 9

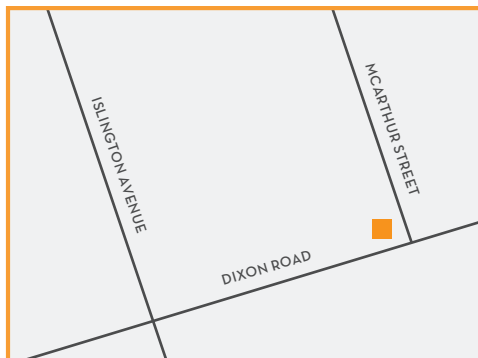

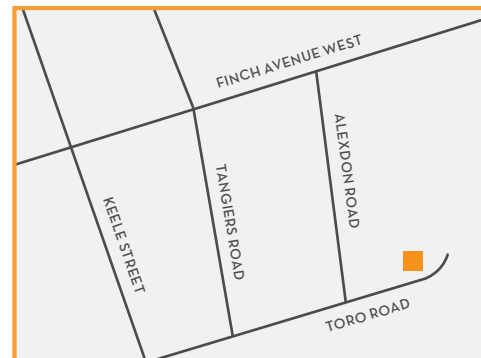
